

Cooking with Valérie

AFMSP is pleased to offer cooking classes with Chef Valérie Faure!

No French experience required, classes will be led in English and French as appropriate for students.

Choose a 2-hour class on Monday mornings, Tuesday evenings or Thursday afternoons, or register for a series of four classes. Class themes and details available at afmsp.org.

We have a selection of different types of classes for every level of student. Content details can be found at afmsp.org

Foundation courses include grammar, vocabulary and practice! Once a week for 3 hours, for 10 weeks. Uses the Alter Ego + method. Materials available for purchase for \$80. \$425 per class (\$14/hr)

Intensive courses meet several times a week to cover foundation materials at a faster pace. Duration and prices vary.

Conversation classes improve your speaking skills. Once a week for 2 hours. \$315 for 10 weeks (\$15.60/hr), \$185 for 5 weeks (\$18.50/hr)

Review classes are ideal for brushing up after a break or consolidating points learned. Once a week for 2 hours, for 5 weeks. \$185 per class (\$18.50/hr)

Workshops & Topics classes allow students to focus on specialized themes related to Francophone culture. Duration and prices vary.

Withdrawal policy:

Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Education Director two weeks before classes begin. A \$15 administrative fee will be deducted for all cancellations.

To receive a refund, withdrawals must be made 2 weeks before classes begin. Membership, registration fees and materials are not refundable. A tuition credit may be issued for withdrawals requested before the end of the second week of classes, for a maximum of 75% of tuition paid minus elapsed classes. There are no credits, discounts or refunds for missed classes.
