

Alliance Française Mpls/St Paul 2023-2024 High School Scholarship Program



Since 2003, Alliance Française Mpls/St Paul has offered students the opportunity to study French language and culture at no cost to them or their families. These scholarships include membership to the Alliance, books and tuition for four class sessions (one calendar year), a total value of \$2,000 per participant. Each spring high school students in 9th-11th grade are invited to apply for the program. Candidates are then assessed by above average GPA, financial need, and whether or not French language classes are offered in their high school.

The mission of the Alliance Française Mpls/St Paul is to promote the use and appreciation of French language and French-speaking culture through language classes, cultural programs, social events and information resources. The Alliance Française presents the art, culture and language of France and French-speaking countries to the Twin Cities, enhancing the lives of our local community through exposure to the international community. The scholarship award presentation takes place at the Alliance Française Annual Meeting of members in June 2024. Students, their families and teachers are invited to attend the ceremony.

Recipients from the 2023-2024 school year came from Minneapolis South High School, Edison High School, North St Paul High School, St Paul Como Park High School and the Math and Science Academy Woodbury.

Please note that Alliance Française classes are offered evenings and weekends at our Minneapolis center or online. In accepting a scholarship from the Alliance Française, students and their families agree to use this opportunity and enroll in classes and to be an active member of our teen club.

A student who does not make good use of this occasion may have the scholarship revoked so another applicant can benefit from it. Applications will be accepted through April 30.
